Description Provide a short description of the event and its activities.				

Round Table on the Green Deal Mobility and gender perspective. Opened debate between the experts and the audience, including students and teachers of Florida University, representatives of public institutions like (Mancomunitat de l'Horta Sud, Diputaciò de València) and partners of the project.

Identification of concrete measures to develop the local Green Deal action plan: In the debate, the experts and the audiencie agreed that sustainable mobility with a gender perspective requires public administrations to integrate Equality technicians into the teams that plan mobility; to act on the basis of political, institutional and technical consensus, as well as institutional coordination; to count on the associative movement for planning; and for society itself to recover its role in making demands.

The event on sustainable mobility with a gender perspective, organized by the Mancomunitat de l'Horta Sud as part of the CLAIRE initiative, significantly impacted Valencia's metropolitan area. It brought together local institutions, mobility professionals, and students from the Florida University's Logistics degree. Discussions highlighted the unequal mobility needs of men and women, stressing the importance of integrating gender perspectives into mobility planning. Recommendations from key speakers, such as urban planner Inés Novella and Julio Huerta from Fundaciò Horta Sud, emphasized the need for gender equality techniques in planning and ensuring public participation in decision-making.

As part of the event, participants visited the Museu Comarcal de l'Horta Sud, a cultural institution dedicated to preserving and showcasing the region's rich history, traditions, and daily life. The visit offered project partners and attendees a chance to understand the local heritage, complementing the discussions on sustainable mobility and gender equality by connecting these contemporary issues with the broader social and cultural context of the area. This stop enriched the overall experience, linking modern urban planning with historical preservation.

Additionally, project partners had the opportunity to explore the Albufera Natural Park, enhancing collaboration in an informal setting. This cultural activity not only fostered networking but also aligned with the project's goals on sustainable tourism. Political representatives from several municipalities attended various informal sessions, further strengthening institutional connections. The event has already led to key recommendations being forwarded to local governments and the Diputació de València (local intermediate authority for province of València).
